Firstly I must apologise for the delay in writing to you. Since coming back to Uganda life has been somewhat hectic and exciting.

In January our Primary Leaving Exam results surprised even us. Hosea was expecting good results but we were 2nd in Kamuli District and with the National reporting in the Media we were suddenly inundated with applications for the school this year. Hosea soon came to me with a problem, "we don't have enough beds or desks" so these had to be made quickly. We now have over 200 children boarding and with the day scholars we now total 460 and still registering. Praise God. We had a gift for the Nursery section and so have begun to buy play equipment for the compound.

With so many of our sponsored students doing well we then had to look for the finances to send them all to Senior School and I am pleased to say every one of them are studying.

February saw the beginning of visitors. Firstly Helen paid her annual visit and Rhiannon, her daughter, came as well. Helen came mainly just as a friend to me and to many people in the village with whom she has become a special visitor. Rhiannon is also special to many but she also went out on Evangelism with Pastor and spoke at the Youth Meeting which was great.

Paul and Lee were our next visitors, the Pastors from Kingdom Life and Forefront Churches, who were housed in our new visitor's quarters – the old dormitory now refurbished. This was both a timely and very blessed time. Apart from ministering in meetings and small groups, they were able to spend time with each senior member of staff individually over a meal. This was good for the staff as well as for Paul and Lee as they got to know each other and talk

about how they would relate together in the future. For me, to hear them saying that this was a very capable team, well able to take over and continue in partnership with them when I leave, gave me great encouragement. Paul, with Christopher baptised some of our new converts and others were baptised later in the week.

At Present I have David Abbott with me and as usual we are having a blessed time with the children. Friday was a bank holiday so we had a children's day with 230 children. On Saturday we had a reunion day for the older children, now youth, who were part of the conferences we had in the past. Sunday we had to put up 2 tents to accommodate the 200 children who came while the adults had the Church Building. We will have to do the same again next Sunday.

Today David has started visiting schools with Hosea and this has given me time to write this letter. In the evenings we will have small children's meeting in the compounds of some of our people in other zones of Kasambira. Next Saturday we have a children's day at our Church in Buwenge so David will be very busy.
